

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1892.

A BY-LAW to authorize the sale of certain Tax Sale lands belonging to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, and to accept in full payment therefor other lands in the Municipality.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the District of Burnaby has acquired under Tax Sale proceedings, lands and premises described as Lots One (1) and Two (2) of Block Five (5) of subdivision of District Lot One hundred and eighty-seven (187), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1282.

AND WHEREAS Hugh Smith, Junior, of 4490 Triumph Street, in the Municipality of Burnaby, Province of British Columbia, is the owner of lands and premises described as Lot Twenty six (26) of Block Twenty six (26), District Lot One hundred and eighty-eight (188), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 1475.

AND WHEREAS the said Hugh Smith, Junior, has requested the Corporation to convey to him the said lands described as Lots 1 and 2, Block 5, D.L. 187, Group 1, New Westminster District, Map No. 1282 and to accept in full payment therefor Conveyance of the said Lot 26, Block 26, D.L. 188, Group 1, New Westminster District, Map No. 1475.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to effect such exchange of lands and premises.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. Upon the execution of delivery to the Corporation of the District of Burnaby by Hugh Smith, Junior, of a good and sufficient Deed of the lands and premises described as Lot 26, Block 26, D.L. 188, Group 1, N.W.D., Map No. 1475 free and clear of all encumbrance whatsoever, the Reeve and Clerk are hereby authorised and empowered to execute and set the official and Corporate seal of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to a Conveyance of lands and premises described as Lots 1 and 2, Block 5, D.L. 187, Group 1, N.W.D., Map

No. 1282, to the said Hugh Smith, Junior, and to deliver such Conveyance when so executed to the said Hugh Smith, Junior.

2. This By-law may be cited as "BURNABY PROPERTY EXCHANGE BY-LAW NO. 3, 1945."

DONE AND PASSED in Open Council this Fifth (5th) day of November, A.D. 1945.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY PASSED by a three-fourths majority of the Municipal Council on this Thirteenth (13th) day of November, A.D. 1945.
