CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1909

A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1725.

THE COUNCIL for the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

- 1. By-law No. 1725 of this Corporation is hereby amended by striking out paragraph One (1) and by substituting therefor the following:
- "1. It shall be lawful for the British Columbia Electric Railway Company, the Neville Transportation Company or any other bus transportation company operating in the Municipality of Burnaby and the driver of any bus used in, upon or about the said services to park the bus for the purpose of taking on passengers or allowing them to alight on the following portions of Edmonds Street, Gilley Avenue, Gilmore Avenue and MacDonald Avenue in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, namely:
- (a) On the northwesterly side of Edmonds Street from a point 78 feet northeasterly from Kingsway to a point 190 feet northeasterly from Kingsway.
- (b) On the southeasterly side of Edmonds Street from a point 53 feet northeasterly from Kingsway to a point 103 feet northeasterly from Kingsway.
- (c) On the West side of Gilley Avenue from a point 25 feet south of Kingsway to a point 75 feet south of Kingsway.
- (d) On the East side of Gilley Avenue from a point 25 feet south of Kingsway to a point 75 feet south of Kingsway.
- (e) On the east side of Gilmore Avenue north of Hastings Street for a distance of sixty feet from Hastings Street.
- (f) On the east side of MacDonald Avenue north of Hastings
 Street for a distance of sixty feet south from the lane between
 Albert Street and Hastings Street.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY BUS PARKING BY-LAW 1941, AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1946."
