THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY
BY-LAW NO. 1917

A BY-LAW consenting to the construction of a railway along a highway within the Municipality of Burnaby.

WHEREAS by Subsection 1 of Section 157 of the "Railway Act" being Chapter 241 of the R.S.B.C. 1936, it is necessary for a railway to obtain the consent of the Municipality by a Bylaw before construeting a railway along any highway within the limits of any Municipality:

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby THEREFORE ENACTS as follows:-

1. The Corporation of the District of Burnaby hereby consents to the B. C. Electric Railway Company Limited to carry their railway along the thirty-three (33') foot road allowance known as Beresford Street between Block numbered Twelve (12) of District Lot numbered Ninety-eight (98), Group One (1), New Westminster District, Map No. 5701 and the right-of-way of the said railway from the east boundary of Antrim Avenue produced East to the centre line of Antrim Avenue and on Antrim Avenue from Beresford Street southeriy as shown on the plan annexed hereto.
2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Burnaby Railway Consent Bylaw No. 2, 1946".
3. This Bylaw shall take effect on being finally reconsidered and adopted.

DONE AND PASSED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby, this Fifteenth (1 Fth) day of July, A.D. 1946.
