

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1933

A BY-LAW to authorize the holding of a referendum on the question "If the Burnaby Transportation By-law 1946 is rejected by the electorate on December 14th, 1946 do you commend to the 1947 Council that it dilligently attempt to inaugurate Municipal bus service if found feasible?"

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 59, Subsection 191, paragraph (a) it is provided that the Council of a Municipal Corporation may from time to time pass By-laws for obtaining, at the time of holding the annual election, the opinion of the municipal electors upon any question which affects the municipality and with which the Municipal Council has power to deal.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby deems it advisable that a referendum should be held to obtain the opinion of the municipal electors on the following question "If the Burnaby Transportation By-law, 1946 is rejected by the electorate on December 14th, 1946 do you commend to the 1947 Council that it diligently attempt to inaugurate Municipal bus service if found feasible?"

THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. That a referendum be submitted for the approval of the Municipal Electorate at the Annual Election to be held on the 14th day of December, 1946 on the following question:-

If the Burnaby Transportation By-law 1946 is rejected by the electorate on December 14th, 1946 do you commend to the 1947 Council that it diligently attempt to inaugurate Municipal bus service if found feasible?

2. That Charles B. Brown, Municipal Clerk, be and is hereby appointed Returning Officer for the purpose of taking the vote of the said electors on the 14th day of December, 1946 and that the times and places of voting be the same as set for the Municipal Election.

3. The persons entitled to vote upon the hereinbefore mentioned referendum shall be such persons as are entitled to vote upon a By-law to contract a debt.

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "BURNABY REFERENDUM BY-LAW NO. 2, 1946"
