

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BY-LAW NO. 1983

A BY-LAW to amend the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:-

1. Section 190 of the Burnaby Building By-law 1926 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

"PROVIDED that the Building Inspector, may at his discretion, permit the use of material other than $\frac{3}{4}$ " shiplap in which case 2" x 4" diagonal wind braces shall be used to the satisfaction of the Building Inspector.

2. Burnaby Building By-law 1926 is hereby further amended by adding as Section 271a. the following:

"271a. Upon the inspection of forms for basement construction where, in the opinion of the Building Inspector, the depth of the basement is below the level of the natural drainage, he shall require the provision of a sump of sufficient dimensions to provide for the installation of a pump."

3. This By-law may be cited as the "Burnaby Building By-law 1926, Amendment By-law 1948."
