BYLAW NO. 10025

A BYLAW respecting the terms of members of  
the Parks and Recreation Commission

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION BYLAW 1969, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1994.

2. Section 3 of Burnaby Parks and Recreation Commission Bylaw 1969 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"3. (1) The Council, at its inaugural meeting each year, shall appoint members for a term of three years to fill vacancies created by members of the Commission whose appointments have expired, and shall appoint two Council members to the Commission for a one-year term.


(2) A member of the Commission whose terms is about to expire shall cease to be a member immediately prior to the inaugural meeting of Council.


(3) A member of Council who is appointed to the Commission shall cease to be a member of the Commission when he or she ceases to be a member of Council."

3. Section 7 of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"7. No person shall be appointed to the Parks and Recreation Commission for more than two consecutive three year terms, but after one year out of office a person is eligible for re-appointment."
