BYLAW NO. 10026

A BYLAW to expropriate certain lands in Burnaby

WHEREAS Council may by bylaw acquire real property for the construction of drainage works for the impounding, conveying and discharging of surface and other waters;

AND WHEREAS for such purposes Council may by bylaw expropriate real property subject to the provisions of the Expropriation Act;

AND WHEREAS the real property hereinafter described is required for the construction of drainage works for the impounding, conveying and discharging of surface and other waters;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY EXPROPRIATION BYLAW 1994.**
2. Council does hereby expropriate for the said purposes that parcel of real property situate, lying and being in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as:

PID No. 017 087 341

All that portion of Parcel One, District Lot 162, Group 1,
New Westminster District, Reference Plan NWP88124
containing by admeasurement 0.146 ha., shown outlined

and described as Parcel "A" on a Reference Plan prepared by R.E. Petersen, B.C.L.S. and dated the 21st day of March, 1994, a copy of which is annexed hereto.
