BYLAW NO. 10033

A BYLAW respecting the provision of accessible parking spaces for disabled persons

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:



1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ZONING BYLAW 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 14, 1994.
2. Section 800.3.1 of Schedule No. VIII of Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965 is repealed and the following substituted therefore:

"Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons:

800.3.1 (1) In addition to the parking spaces for the use of disabled persons that are required to be provided by the British Columbia Building Code, at least one parking space for the use of disabled persons shall be provided in a parking lot that has more than twenty-five and less than fifty-one parking spaces.

(2) Each parking space for the use of disabled persons shall be marked with a sign that identifies the space for use as disabled parking in compliance with the specifications in Schedule 2 of Division 23 of the regulations pursuant to the Motor Vehicle Act, and shall have the parking surface marked with the international symbol for wheelchair accessibility."
