BYLAW NO. 10056

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the  
Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment  
Reserve Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$53,451,125.70 as at the 22nd day of May, 1994, calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$235,200 of the said balance to fund Parks and Recreation 1994 capital projects:

- (a) Burnaby Lake Park  
Improvements to tennis courts to meet user demand.
- (b) Burnaby Lake Arena  
Installation of rink boards

- (c) Burnaby Village Museum  
Installation of new alarm system to improve security  
Restoration of museum buildings
- (d) Deer Lake Park  
Banners to enhance the precinct
- (e) Outdoor Pools  
To conduct a condition survey on pool tanks, mechanical systems and buildings  
at four outdoor pools

(hereinafter called "the said works");

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 11, 1994.
2. The sum of \$235,200 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.
3. Should any of the said sum of \$235,200 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
