BYLAW NO. 10086

A BYLAW to stop up and close to traffic portion of road

WHEREAS that portion of road shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 12381 is no longer required for road purposes;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BYLAW NO. 2, 1994.
- 2. That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as that portion of road in District Lot 86, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by the deposit of Plan 12381 containing by admeasurement 287 m² shown outlined on the plan prepared by D.A. Le Patourel, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 8th day of June, 1994, a copy of which is annexed hereto, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the said portion of road more particularly described in section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of the City of Burnaby.

HIGHWAY ABANDONMENT

WHEREAS the Council of The City of Burnaby has by Bylaw No. 10086 cited as "Burnaby Road Closing Bylaw No. 2, 1994" a copy of which is hereto attached, stopped up and closed to traffic that portion of highway as shown in heavy outline on the plan attached to and made part of said Bylaw No. 10086 and more particularly described as follows:

P.I.D. 018-936-423 Parcel A (Bylaw Plan LMP 18481) District Lot 86 Group 1 New Westminster District dedicated Road on Plan 12381

AND WHEREAS the Council has requested the Minister of Municipal Affairs to abandon the aforesaid portion of highway under Section 573 of the *Municipal Act* and to vest title to the land comprising same in the name of the municipality and has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Minister that special circumstances exist which warrant the making of this Order:

AND WHEREAS the consent of owners of contiguous properties have been obtained and the question of access is not in issue:

I HEREBY order that the portion of highway aforesaid be abandoned and that title to the lands comprising same be vested in fee simple in the name of the City of Burnaby without further instrument of transfer subject nevertheless to the reservations, limitations, provisos and conditions expressed in the original grant thereof from the Crown and subject to the provisions of Section 47 of the Land Act.
