A BYLAW to expropriate certain lands in Burnaby

WHEREAS Council may by bylaw acquire real property for the establishment of a highway;

AND WHEREAS for such purposes Council may by bylaw expropriate real property subject to the provisions of the Expropriation Act;

AND WHEREAS the real property hereinafter described is required for the establishment of a highway;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:
