BYLAW NO. 10155

A BYLAW respecting mobile retail carts

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ZONING BYLAW 1965, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 55, 1994.

2. Section 3 of Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965 is amended by adding thereto, immediately after the definition "mobile home park", the following definition:

"'mobile retail cart' means a cart having maximum ground coverage of 3.72 m<sup>2</sup> (40 sq.ft.) that is capable of being moved by one person and is intended for use as a temporary location for the retail of goods or services."

3. Section 302.1 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately after item (16), the following:

"(17) Mobile retail carts not exceeding three in number as a use accessory to a principal retail use."

4. Item (27) of section 303.1 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(27) Mobile retail carts not exceeding three in number as a use accessory to a principal retail use."

5. Section 304.1 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately after item (35), the following:

"(36) Mobile retail carts not exceeding three in number as a use accessory to a principal retail use."



6. Section 308.2 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately after item (15), the following:

"(16) Mobile retail carts not exceeding three in number as a use accessory to a principal retail use."

7. Item (1) of section 401.1 of Schedule Number III of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately after paragraph (r), the following:

"(s) Mobile retail carts not exceeding three in number as a use accessory to a principal retail use."
