BYLAW NO. 10167

A BYLAW to authorize the construction of
certain local improvement works
upon petition

WHEREAS Council has received a petition to construct the local improvement works hereinafter described and the City Clerk has certified that the said petition is sufficient;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition in the manner hereinafter provided;

AND WHEREAS Council has had prepared the report required by section 662 of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS the lifetime of the said works is twenty years;

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the said works is \$254,515.00;

AND WHEREAS the share or portion of the cost of the said works that should be borne by the parcels of land that abut or are deemed to abut on the said works is \$201,609.97;

AND WHEREAS the City's share or proportion of the cost of the said works is \$52,905.03;

AND WHEREAS the special charges should be made payable in ten annual instalments.

AND WHEREAS the total amount proposed to be borrowed under this Bylaw,

namely \$254,515, does not exceed the total amount of borrowing approved by the Inspector of Municipalities for local improvement purposes less the amount already borrowed under such authorization;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CONSTRUCTION BYLAW NO. 1, 1995.

2. The Council of the City of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to construct as a local improvement under the provisions of Part 16 of the Municipal Act all necessary equipment, wires, and works, including standards and underground conduits, for the purpose of supplying public lighting for the following streets:

- (a) Burke Street from Smith Avenue to Inman Avenue and Hertford Street from Smith Avenue to Inman Avenue
- (b) Elsom Avenue from Sardis Street to Bond Street
- (c) Ewart Street from Royal Oak Avenue to MacPherson Avenue and Roslyn Avenue from Ewart Street to McKee Street
- (d) Gray Avenue from Imperial Street to Victory Street
- (e) Greenall Avenue from Rumble Street to Southwood Street
- (f) Greta Street from Willingdon Avenue to the cul-de-sac
- (g) Pandora Street from Duthie Avenue to the eastern property line of 7327 Pandora Street
- (h) Patrick Street from Royal Oak Avenue to MacPherson Avenue
- (i) Portland Street from MacPherson Avenue east to ravine and MacPherson Avenue from Portland Street to McKee Street
- (j) Sherban Court from 5815 Court east to cul-de-sac

- (k) Sherlock Avenue from Kitchener Street to Curtis Street
- (l) Watling Street from Nelson Avenue to Royal Oak Avenue
- (m) Willingdon Avenue from Watling Street to Victory Street
- (n) Winch Street from Sperling Avenue to Cliff Avenue

3. The Clerk is authorized and empowered to cause a contract for the construction of the said works to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of Council to be declared by resolution.

4. The special charges shall be paid by ten annual instalments.

5. The Assessor shall forthwith prepare a frontage tax assessment roll in respect of the said works pursuant to Section 483 of the Municipal Act and in accordance with the provisions of Bylaw No. 8417, as amended, and shall from time to time revise the said frontage tax assessment roll in accordance with subsection (3) of the said Section 483.
