BYLAW NO. 10420

A BYLAW to authorize the construction of  
certain local improvement works  
upon petition

WHEREAS Council has received a petition to construct the local improvement works hereinafter described and the City Clerk has certified that the said petition is sufficient;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition in the manner hereinafter provided;

AND WHEREAS Council has had prepared the report required by section 662 of the *Municipal Act*;

AND WHEREAS the lifetime of the said works is twenty years;

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of the said works is \$240,000.00;

AND WHEREAS the share or portion of the cost of the said works that should be borne by the parcels of land that abut or are deemed to abut on the said works is \$153,597.24;

AND WHEREAS the City's share or proportion of the cost of the said works is \$86,402.76;

AND WHEREAS the special charges should be made payable in ten annual instalments;

AND WHEREAS the total amount proposed to be borrowed under this Bylaw, namely \$240,000, does not exceed the total amount of borrowing approved by the Inspector of Municipalities for local improvement purposes less the amount already borrowed under such authorization;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT CONSTRUCTION BYLAW NO. 2, 1996.
  
2. The Council of the City of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to construct as a local improvement under the provisions of Part 16 of the Municipal Act all necessary equipment, wires, and works, including standards and underground conduits, for the purpose of supplying public lighting for the following streets:
  - (a) Arbor Street from Boundary Road to Joffre Avenue
  - (b) Bessborough Drive from Holdom Avenue to dead end (5521 Bessborough Drive)
  - (c) Chiselhampton Street from Canada Way to Rugby Street; Rugby Street from Sperling Avenue to existing lights east of Chiselhampton Street, and Clayton Court from Rugby Street to end
  - (d) Dow Avenue from Imperial Street to Beresford Street
  - (e) Kitchener Street from Sperling Avenue to Cliff Avenue
  - (f) Mandy Avenue from Hurst Street to Imperial Street
  - (g) Mary Avenue from 16th Avenue to 14th Avenue, and 14th Avenue from Mary Avenue to lane north of Mary Avenue
  - (h) Portland Street from Gilley Avenue to ravine west of Buller Avenue
  - (i) St. Charles Place from Bryant Street to cul-de-sac, and Hambry Street from St. Charles Place to Waltham Avenue



- (j) 17th Avenue from Mary Avenue to Humphries Avenue, and Mary Avenue from 18th Avenue to 17th Avenue
- (k) 16th Avenue from Canada Way to Mary Avenue, and Mary Avenue from 16th Avenue to 17th Avenue
- (l) William Street from Gilmore Avenue to MacDonald Avenue.

3. The Clerk is authorized and empowered to cause a contract for the construction of the said works to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of Council to be declared by resolution.

4. The special charges shall be paid by ten annual instalments.

5. The Assessor shall forthwith prepare a frontage tax assessment roll in respect of the said works pursuant to Section 483 of the *Municipal Act* and in accordance with the provisions of Bylaw No. 8417, as amended, and shall from time to time revise the said frontage tax assessment roll in accordance with subsection (3) of the said Section 483.
