BYLAW NO. 10546

A BYLAW to set fees for tax information certificates

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY TAX INFORMATION CERTIFICATE FEES BYLAW 1997.
2. In this Bylaw, "tax information certificate" means a certificate showing
 - (a) the amount of unpaid taxes charged against specified real property,
 - (b) whether the real property has been sold for taxes, and
 - (c) if the property has been sold for taxes, the time remaining for redemption, if any, and the amount required to redeem it.
3. The fee for a tax information certificate shall be \$20.00.
4. Bylaw 9839, being Burnaby Tax Certificate Fees Bylaw, is repealed.
