## A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$77,226,621.80 as at the 3rd day of December, 1997, calculated as follows:

for:

- the Willingdon Urban Trail (Deer Lake Parkway to Sanderson Way);
- the North/South Bike Route (Canada Way to Metrotown);

completion of the Burnaby Mountain Urban Trail (Production Way to end of Eastlake Drive section, and traffic signalization of Broadway and Underhill Avenue

(hereinafter called "the said works");

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 38, 1997.

2. The sum of \$641,000 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.

3. Should any of the said sum of \$641,000 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
