CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 10702

A BYLAW to amend Burnaby Second-hand Dealers Regulation By-Law 1924

The Council of City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY SECOND-HAND DEALERS REGULATION BY-LAW 1924, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1998.
- 2. Section 1 of Burnaby Second-Hand Dealers Regulation By-Law 1924 is amended:
 - (a) by striking out subsection (h) and substituting therefor the following:
 - "(h) The term "second-hand dealer" means any person who carries on the trade or business that includes the purchase or sale of any two or more of the following types or classes of secondhand or used goods, wares or merchandise;
 - (i) radios, stereos, compact disc players, tape recorders, tape players or other audio equipment;
 - (ii) televisions, projectors or other video equipment;
 - (iii) electronic office equipment, including photocopiers and telecopiers;
 - (iv) telephones;
 - (v) computers and computer equipment and accessories;
 - (vi cameras, camcorders and camera equipment and accessories;
 - (vii) compact discs or cassette tapes;

	(viii)	bicycles;				
	(ix)	sports equipment;				
	(x)	tools;				
	(xi)	musical instruments or equipment;				
	(xii)	jewellery;				
but does not include dealers in secondhand or used clothing, appliances or funiture who do not operate for profit;"						
by adding thereto the following after subsection (h):						
"(i)	The term "picture identification" means any one of the following, provided that it contains a photograph of the person in whose name it is issued					
	(i)	a valid driver's licence or identity card issued by the government of a Province or Territory of Canada;				
	(ii)	a passport issued by the government of the country of origin;				
	(iii)	a Certificate of Indian Status issued by the Government of Canada;				
	(iv)	a Certificate of Canadian Citizenship issued by the Government of Canada;				
	(v)	a Conditional Release Card issued by Correctional Services Canada;".				

3. Section 7 of the said Bylaw is amended:

(b)

by striking out all of subsection (a) following the word "namely" in the fifth line and (a)

substituting therefor the following:

- "(1) A full and complete description, including the make, model and serial number or other distinguishing marks or name of any goods, articles or things purchased or received;
- (2) The price paid for such goods, articles or things;
- (3) The precise date and time of purchasing or receiving such goods, articles or things;
- (4) The name, residential address and description of the person from whom such goods, articles or things were purchased or received;
- (5) A complete description of the picture identification required to be produced under subsection (b2) including the name, residential address, birthdate, licence or identification number and the name of the authority that issued the picture identification; and
- (6) The make, model, colour and licence plate number of any motor vehicle used by the person from whom such goods, articles or things were purchased or received for the purpose of delivering those goods, articles or things;

and shall cause the person from whom such goods, articles or things were purchased or received to sign the book."

- (b) by adding thereto the following after subsection (b):
 - "(b2) No second-hand dealer or junk dealer shall purchase or receive any goods,

articles or things from any person unless that person produces two pieces of identification, including one piece of picture identification, to verify his or her identity.

- (b3) No second-hand dealer or junk dealer shall purchase any goods, articles or things the serial number or other identifying mark of which has been removed or rendered illegible."
- (c) by striking out all of subsection (e) following the word "him" in the eighth line and substituting therefor the following:

"setting forth, with respect to each and every good, article or thing purchased by him during the week immediately preceding the hour of 8:30 a.m. on the day on which the report is made, all of the information required to be recorded under section 7(a)."

- (d) by adding thereto the following after subsection (m):
 - "(n) Every second-hand dealer shall maintain a current list of the names of all persons employed by that second-hand dealer in his or her business, and shall make that list available for inspection upon demand by the Chief Constable of the Municipality;
 - (o) No second-hand dealer or junk dealer shall sell, dispose of or otherwise part with any goods, articles or things purchased or received by him or her or allow any such goods, articles or things to be removed from his or her business premises until after the expiration of fourteen (14) clear days from the date on which the purchase or receipt of those goods, articles or things was reported to the Chief Constable of the Municipality pursuant to section 7(e), and, if so

directed by the Chief Constable, for a further period of fourteen (14) clear days thereafter;".

4. Section 11 of the said Bylaw is amended by deleting therefrom the words and figures "not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00)" and substituting therefor the words and figures "of not less than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars and not exceeding two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars".
