1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 12, 1998.

2. The sum of \$187,250 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.

3. Should any of the said sum of \$187,250 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
