## **BYLAW NO. 10828**

## A BYLAW to permit dogs to be unleashed while on certain specified areas of certain City parks

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

## This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW 1991, AMENDMENT BYLAW 1998.

2. Section 5 of the Burnaby Animal Control Bylaw 1991 is amended by adding thereto the following subsections:

- "(5) Notwithstanding subsection (1) and section 9(1) a dog is not required to be on a leash
  - (a) in that part of Confederation Park shown as a permitted off-leash area on the plan attached hereto as Schedule "A",
  - (b) in that part of Robert Burnaby Park shown as a permitted off-leash area on the plan attached hereto as Schedule "B",
  - (c) in that part of Fraser Foreshore Park shown as a permitted off-leash area on the plan attached hereto as Schedule "C", between October 1, 1998 and March 31, 1999, and
  - (d) in that part of Barnet Marine Park shown as a permitted

off-leash area on the plan attached hereto as Schedule "D", between October 1, 1998 and March 31, 1999.

(6) The owner or possessor of any dog that is lawfully not on a leash pursuant to subsection (5) shall

- (a) keep the dog under control by verbal command at all times, and
- (b) ensure that the dog does not cause injury to any person or other animal or damage to any property."






