## BYLAW NO. 10984

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$79,012,176.03 as at the 21st day of July, 1999, calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$3,961,225 of the said balance to finance the construction of the proposed No. 5 Fire Station and Public Parking Lot at Hastings Street and Carleton Avenue (hereinafter called "the said works");

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS, MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 29, 1999.
- 2. The sum of \$3,961,225 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.
- 3. Should any of the said sum of \$3,961,225 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
