BYLAW NO. 11033

A BYLAW to temporarily permit dogs to be unleashed
while on certain specified areas of Burnaby
Fraser Foreshore Park

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW 1991, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2, 1999.**

2. Subsection 5(5) of Burnaby Animal Control Bylaw 1991 is amended as follows:
 - (a) by striking out the word "and" where it appears at the end of subsection 5(5)(c);

 - (b) by inserting the word "and" after the words "March 31, 2000" where they appear in subsection 5(5)(d); and

 - (c) by adding the following as subsection (e) immediately following subsection (d):

"e) for the two year period commencing April 1, 2000 and ending March 31, 2002, in that part of Burnaby Fraser

Foreshore Park shown as a permitted off-leash area on the plan attached hereto as Schedule 'E'."

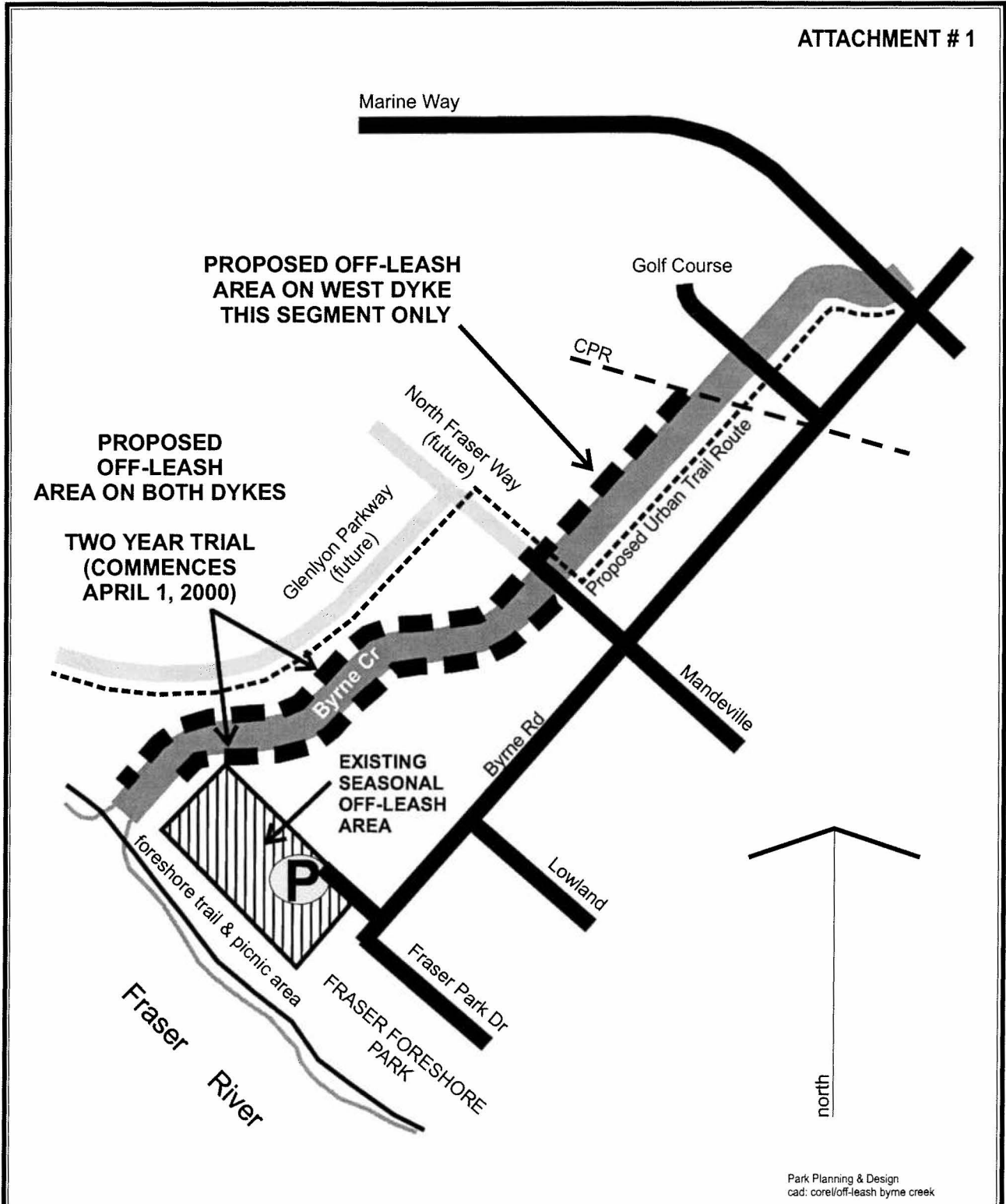
