BYLAW NO. 11038

A BYLAW to establish the due date for the payment of property taxes and to establish percentage additions thereto pursuant to section 394 of the *Municipal Act*

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY PROPERTY TAX PAYMENT DATE BYLAW 1999.**
2. In this Bylaw the term "business day" means any day other than a Saturday, Sunday or holiday.
3. (1) The collector shall on the third business day after the first day of July in each year add to the unpaid property taxes of that year for each parcel of land and its improvements on the property tax roll, five percent of the amount of the property taxes unpaid at the end of the second business day after the first day of July in that year.



(2) The collector shall on the third business day in September of each year add to the unpaid property taxes of that year for each parcel of land and its improvements on the property tax roll, five percent of the amount of the property taxes unpaid at the end of the second business day of September in that year.
