## Removal, Disposal and Cremation Fees

(1)	For each dead body of a horse, mule, ass, cattle, sheep, goat or swine	\$50.00

(3)	There shall be payable in respect of the animals or poultry described in items (1) and (2) in addition to the fee specified therein, all costs of removal and disposal	
(4)	Notwithstanding anything in this Schedule contained, licenced veterinarians and other agencies approved by Council shall pay for the disposal of animals and poultry	\$.40 per pound With minimum charge of \$8.00
(5)	For each dead body of a cat or dog	\$.40 per pound With minimum charge of \$8.00
