## **BYLAW NO. 11134**

## A BYLAW respecting small lot subdivisions in the R4 and R5 Districts

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY ZONING BYLAW 1965**, **AMENDMENT NO. 30, 2000**.
- 2. Subsection (2) of section 104.2 of Schedule Number I of Burnaby Zoning Bylaw 1965 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "(2) R4 Single Family Dwelling Small. Notwithstanding section 104.2(1), where 30 percent or more of the existing lots with
    - (a) the zoning designations R4, R5 or R9, or
    - (b) the zoning designation RM3 that are developed with a single family dwelling and are designated on the Official Community Plan for single and two family residential use

in the block front have a width of 13.72 m (45.0 ft.) or less, each lot shall have an area of not less than  $399.47 \text{ m}^2$  (4300.0 sq.ft.) and a width of not less than 10.97 m (36.0 ft.)."

- 3. Subsection (2) of section 105.2 of Schedule Number I of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
  - "(2) R5 Single Family Dwelling Small. Notwithstanding section 105.2(1), where 30 percent or more of the existing lots with
    - (a) the zoning designations R4, R5 or R9, or

(b) the zoning designation RM3 that are developed with a single family dwelling and are designated on the Official Community Plan for single and two family residential use

in the block front have a width of 13.72~m (45.0~ft.) or less, each lot shall have an area of not less than  $334.40~m^2$  (3600.0~sq.ft.) and a width of not less than 9.14~m (30.0~ft.)."
