

**CITY OF BURNABY**

**BYLAW NO. 11188**

A BYLAW respecting special safety inspections  
following electrical or gas disconnections

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY BUILDING BYLAW 1973, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2, 2000.**

2. Burnaby Building Bylaw 1973 is amended by adding thereto, as subsection (5) of section 5, the following:

"(5) If the supply of electricity or natural gas to a building has been disconnected due to a hazardous or potentially hazardous situation existing in the building, the supply of electricity or natural gas to the building shall not be reconnected, the building shall not be occupied, and the Building Inspector may withhold a permit to reconnect the supply of electricity or natural gas to the building, until

(a) the owner has applied to the Building Inspector for a special safety inspection pursuant to this section and has paid the fee therefor specified in Appendix "A" to this Bylaw;



(b) the building has been inspected by the Building Inspector and the City Fire Chief or their assistants for compliance with this Bylaw, Burnaby Electrical Bylaw 1974, Burnaby Plumbing Bylaw 1973, Burnaby Gas Bylaw 1978, Burnaby Fire Services Bylaw 1983 and any Provincial statute or regulation relating to building, electrical, gas or fire safety;

- (c) the owner has obtained any permits required to carry out the works necessary to bring the building into compliance with the bylaws, statutes, and regulations referred to in subsection (b);
- (d) all of the works referred to in subsection (c) have been completed and the building has been brought into compliance with the bylaws, statutes and regulations referred to in subsection (b)."

3. Appendix "A" of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, as subsection (d) of section 8, the following:

"(d) For a special safety inspection following an electrical or gas disconnection	\$300"
