BYLAW NO. 11196

A BYLAW to dispose of a certain portion of
highway in exchange for other lands

WHEREAS pursuant to section 525 of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996 the Council may by bylaw dispose of any portion of a highway in exchange for such lands as may be necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS a disposition under this section has the same effect as a Crown grant, free of all rights of way, and all lands taken in exchange for any portion of a highway under this section are public highways, and the title thereto is vested in the Crown;

AND WHEREAS the Council, before adopting this Bylaw, has caused the required statutory public notice of its intention to be given by advertisement;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to stop up and close to traffic that portion of highway more particularly hereinafter described for the purpose of relocating and diverting a highway;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY HIGHWAY EXCHANGE BYLAW NO. 3, 2000.**
2. The Council of the City of Burnaby is hereby authorized and empowered to stop up and close to traffic ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as all that portion of road in District Lot 69, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 1321, containing 231 m², (hereinafter called "the said closed portion of road") and shown hatched on Reference Plan prepared by Robert M. Reese, B.C.L.S., deposited in the Land Title Office under Number LMP _____, a copy of which is hereunto annexed (hereinafter called "the said plan").


3. The Council is further authorized and empowered to grant and convey the said closed portion of road unto the registered owners of Parcel Identifiers 001-049-046 and 011-826-835, Lots 6 and 7, Block 10, District Lot 69, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1321 (hereinafter called "the said lots") in exchange for those portions of the said lots containing 95 m² and 95 m², respectively, shown outlined on the said plan, and those portions of the said lots shall, upon deposit of the necessary transfers in the Land Title Office, be public highway and title thereto shall be vested in the Crown.

4. Burnaby Highway Exchange Bylaw No. 19, 1989, Bylaw No. 9301, is repealed.
