CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 11232

A BYLAW to permit freestanding illuminated changing message signs on certain properties in the P3 Zoning District

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY SIGN BYLAW 1972**, **AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2001**.
- 2. Section 1 of Schedule No. III of Burnaby Sign Bylaw 1972 is amended by adding thereto, immediately after subsection (4), the following subsection:
 - "(5) In a P3 District corresponding to a major park complex of city-wide significance and fronting an arterial road, a permitted freestanding sign may be an illuminated changing message system sign."
- 3. Section 2 of Schedule No. III of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately after subsection (4), the following subsection:
 - "(5) An illuminated changing message system component in a freestanding sign in a P3 District:
 - (a) shall be part of a Comprehensive Sign Plan,
 - (b) shall be restricted to event and facility information and public service messages,
 - (c) shall have static messages capable of instantaneous change from one message to another, and

- (d) shall not exceed a maximum changing message component area of 3.72 m² (40 sq.ft) per side and a maximum of two sides."
- 4. Section 2A of Schedule No. VI of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, after the words "this Bylaw", the words "and for a major park complex".
