CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 11241

A BYLAW to limit the size and weight of household garbage receptacles and provide for yardwaste receptacles

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY SOLID WASTE BYLAW 1981**, **AMENDMENT BYLAW 2001**.
- 2. Subsection (9) of section 2 of Burnaby Solid Waste Bylaw 1981 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:
 - "(9) 'household receptacle' means a plastic bag that
 - (a) is strong enough to withstand normal handling and lifting
 - (b) when full, has a gross weight not exceeding 20 kg
 - (c) is closed and sealed
 - (d) contains no glassware, bottles or sharp pieces of wood or metal that might tear the bag

or a plastic or galvanized iron or other rust resisting metal container having

- (e) a volume not exceeding 77 litres and, when full, a gross weight not exceeding 20 kg
- (f) a shape and opening that permits emptying with minimum effort

- (g) handles or handling devices that enable the container to be lifted and emptied safely by one person
- (h) a watertight, removable cover."
- 3. The following subsection is added to section 2 of the said Bylaw immediately following subsection (19):
 - "(20) 'yardwaste receptacle' means a bag or container that
 - (a) is strong enough to withstand normal handling and lifting
 - (b) that is made of transparent non-coloured plastic or, in the case of a container, has affixed to it a 'Yard Trimmings' label provided by the City of Burnaby
 - (c) when full, has a gross weight not exceeding 20 kg
 - (d) has a volume not exceeding 77 litres
 - (e) is closed and sealed
 - (f) contains only garden refuse"
- 4. Subsection (1)(a) of section 4 of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately following the words "household receptacles" where they appear, the words "and yardwaste receptacles".
- 5. Section 10 of the said Bylaw is amended by striking out the words "household receptacle" where they appear and substituting in their place the words "yardwaste receptacle".
- 6. Subsection (1) of section 14 of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately following the words "specially authorized service" where they appear, the words ", or a disposal area operated by the City of Burnaby,".

- 7. Schedule "A" of the said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately following paragraph B(2), the following:
 - "C Burnaby Yardwaste Depot charges:
 - (a) \$48 per tonne, inclusive of GST
 - (b) no minimum charge
 - (c) no fee for a resident of Burnaby with a load of 50 kg or less (limit of one free visit per day)"
