BYLAW NO. 11291

A BYLAW to exempt from taxation certain lands and improvements pursuant to section 341(1) and (2)(n) of the Local Government Act

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BYLAW NO.** 10, 2001.

2. Pursuant to section 341(1) and (2)(n) of the *Local Government Act*, Council does hereby exempt from taxation under section 359(1)(a) of the said Act for the year 2002 fifty percent of the interest in a municipal building of a non-profit organization that uses or occupies the building as a licensee or tenant of the City of Burnaby, namely, 9048 Stormont Avenue (Roll No. 3242-9048) more particularly described as Lot 9 except part in Statutory Right of Way Plan 26009, District Lot 14, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 12158, occupied by Pacific Assistance Dogs Society, SAVE AND EXCEPT that portion of the improvements used for residential purposes and a proportionate area of the land as shown on plan annexed to Bylaw No. 10285, filed in the Land Title Office in New Westminster.
