BYLAW NO. 11295

A BYLAW to exempt from taxation certain property
pursuant to section 341(2)(i) of the
Local Government Act

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION BYLAW NO. 14, 2001.**

2. Pursuant to section 341(2)(i) of the *Local Government Act*, Council does hereby exempt from taxation under section 359(1)(a) of the said Act for the year 2002, 50 percent of the museum building, 50 percent of the parking under the museum building, 50 percent of the area of land occupied by the museum building, and 100 percent of the land used as a Japanese garden owned by the NATIONAL NIKKEI HERITAGE CENTRE SOCIETY, 6688 Southoaks Crescent (Roll No. 3261-6688) more particularly described as Lot 8, District Lot 96, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan LMP20410.

The herein described tax-exempt parcel contains by calculation 2876 square metres, and is shown outlined in black on the plan annexed to Bylaw No. 11168 filed in the Land Title Office at New Westminster.
