
A BYLAW to stop up and close to traffic
portion of road

WHEREAS that portion of road shown on the plan annexed hereto dedicated by Plan 2855 is no longer required for road purposes;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY ROAD CLOSING BYLAW NO. 2, 2001.**
2. That portion of road situate, lying and being in the Municipality of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, and being more particularly known and described as that portion of road in District Lot 119, Group 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by the deposit of Plan 2855 containing by admeasurement 0.106 ha., shown outlined on the plan prepared by G.N. Holme, B.C.L.S., certified correct the 14th day of November, 2000, a copy of which is annexed hereto, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and empowered to petition the Minister of Community, Aboriginal and Women's Services to abandon the said portion of road more particularly described in section 2 hereof and vest title thereto in the name of the City of Burnaby.
