

## CITY OF BURNABY

### BYLAW NO. 11456

A BYLAW to regulate therapeutic  
touch treatment businesses

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY ADULT SERVICE BUSINESS REGULATION BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW 2002.**
2. Subsection (c) of section 2 of Burnaby Adult Service Business Regulation Bylaw 2001 is amended by adding thereto immediately after the words "day spa", the words "or therapeutic touch treatment business".
3. Section 2 of the said Bylaw is amended by:
  - (a) deleting the period at the end of subsection (i) and substituting a semi-colon in its place;
  - (b) adding thereto, immediately after subsection (i), the following:
    - "(j) 'therapeutic touch treatment business' means a business or premises that provides shiatsu, reflexology, biokineisiology, hellework, polarity, reiki, aromatherapy or other therapeutic touch treatment services."
4. Section 11 of the said Bylaw is renumbered section 13.
5. The said Bylaw is amended by adding thereto, immediately after section 10, the following:
  - "11. Every owner or operator of a therapeutic touch treatment business shall maintain at its business a written record of the name, address and age of each employee, which shall be made available for inspection by the Chief Constable or any police officer under his command.

12. No owner or operator of a therapeutic touch treatment business shall carry on business or remain open for business between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m on the following day."
