## **BYLAW NO. 11460**

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund

**WHEREAS** there is an unappropriated balance in the Capital Works, Machinery and Equipment Reserve Fund (hereinafter called "the said Reserve Fund") established pursuant to Bylaw No. 7256 of \$77,005,354.70 as at the 31st day of October, 2002, calculated as follows:

**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed desirable to expend \$75,000 of the said balance to finance the construction of a one-way northbound lane between Percival Avenue and Spruce Street and a raised centre median on Spruce Street at Canada Way (hereinafter called "the said works");

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY CAPITAL WORKS**, **MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT RESERVE FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 29, 2002.**
- 2. The sum of \$75,000 is hereby appropriated from the said Reserve Fund to be expended for the said works.
- 3. Should any of the said sum of \$75,000 remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
