BYLAW NO. 11488

A BYLAW amend fees payable under the Electrical Bylaw

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY ELECTRICAL BYLAW 1974, AMENDMENT BYLAW 2002.**
2. Appendix "A" of Burnaby Electrical Bylaw 1974 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

3. Temporary Current Permit: (not required for one or two-family dwelling)	\$126.75
4. Annual Permit for one commercial or industrial plant or establishment (based on service capacity) For each additional permit	\$0.24 per KVA Minimum \$125 Maximum \$2,225 \$78.50
5. Temporary Saw Service:	Fee based on value of electrical installation (Minimum \$80.00)
6. Modifications of Drawings and Specifications:	\$60 per hour (\$30.00 minimum)
7. Permit Fee to Record Work Done Without Permit and Inspection: Where electrical work has been carried out without a permit and a permit is accepted to approve and inspect the work after the fact, the fee shall be calculated under section 2 of Appendix "A" based on the value of the electrical installation as estimated by the Chief Building Inspector at the time of application for the Electrical Permit (minimum \$80.00)	
8. Permit Fee Refund: Where no work has been performed under the permit, the refund will be 90% of the fee paid subject to a minimum non-refundable of \$100.00. No refunds will be given unless a written request is received by the Chief Building Inspector.	
9. Permit Extension:	\$42.50
10. Signs: (a) Neon	\$75 for first transformer, \$50 each for the next two transformers \$35 each for the next two transformers

Travel time included.</p> <p>\$75 per hour (\$75 minimum)</p> <p>\$150.00</p>
<p>14. Permit Transfer or Assignment Fee:</p> <p>For the transfer or assignment of an electrical permit or to record a change of contractor for a project</p>	<p>\$42.50</p>
