BYLAW NO. 11500

A BYLAW to amend Burnaby Smoking Regulation Bylaw 1996

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY SMOKING REGULATION BYLAW 1996, AMENDMENT BYLAW 2003.**
2. Subsection (e) of Section 2 of Burnaby Smoking Regulation Bylaw 1996 is repealed and the following substituted in its place:

“(e) ‘liquor licence establishment’ means an establishment that holds a liquor primary licence or a liquor primary club licence under the Liquor Control and Licensing Act.”
3. Sections 5 and 6 of the said Bylaw are amended by striking out the words “liquor outlet licensed under the provisions of the Liquor Control and Licensing Act as Class ‘A’, ‘C’ or ‘D’” and substituting in their place the words “liquor licence establishment”.
