BYLAW NO. 11697

A BYLAW respecting continuously sounding car
alarms on public highways

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY STREET AND TRAFFIC BYLAW 1961, AMENDMENT BYLAW 2004.**
2. Section 18A of Burnaby Street and Traffic Bylaw 1961 is amended:
 - (a) by striking out subsections (a) and (b); and
 - (b) by adding, immediately after the word "paid", where it appears, the words "within fifteen (15) days of the violation, the fine shall be \$25."
3. The said Bylaw is further amended by adding thereto the following section immediately after section 26:

"26A (1) No owner or lessee of a vehicle equipped with a security alarm system shall permit, allow or suffer that security alarm system to sound

 - (a) either continuously or intermittently for a period of one minute or longer; or
 - (b) more than three times in a twenty four hour period;

while that vehicle is parked on a highway or public place.

(2) A vehicle equipped with a security alarm system that has sounded in contravention of subsection (1) shall, for the purposes of this Bylaw, be deemed to be unlawfully occupying that portion of the highway or public place where it is parked."
