## BYLAW NO. 11700

### A BYLAW to amend Burnaby Heritage Advisory Committee Bylaw

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY HERITAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW 2004.**
2. Section 1 of Burnaby Heritage Advisory Committee Bylaw is amended by striking out the word "HERITAGE ADVISORY COMMITTEE" and substituting "COMMUNITY HERITAGE COMMISSION".
3. Sections 2(a) & 3 of the said Bylaw is amended by striking out the words "Heritage Advisory Committee" and substituting "Community Heritage Commission".
4. Sections 2(a), 4, 5(1), (2), (4) and (5) and 6(4), (6) and (7) of the said Bylaw are amended by striking out the word "Committee" and substituting "Commission".
5. Section 2(b) of the said Bylaw is amended by striking out the words "The Corporation of the District" and substituting "the City".
6. Section 4 of the said Bylaw is amended by striking out the words "Part 3 of the Heritage Conservation Act" and substituting "Part 27 of the *Local Government Act*".
7. Section 5(1) of the said Bylaw is amended:
  - (a) by striking out subsection (d) and substituting the following:  
"(d) one member from the community at large"; and
  - (b) by striking out the words "one historian or archivist" in subsection (e) and substituting "one person from the community with a background in history, architecture, archival studies or a related field".
8. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 6 of the said Bylaw are struck out and the following substituted:
  - "(1) Council shall annually appoint from the two members of Council on the Commission a Chair, and that person shall preside over the meetings for one year or until replaced by a new Chair.
  - (2) Council shall annually appoint from the two members of Council on the Commission a Vice-chair, and that person shall preside over the meetings in the absence of the Chair for one year or until replaced by a new Vice-Chair."
