BYLAW NO. 11809

A BYLAW to exempt from taxation certain property
pursuant to section 224(1) and (2)(a) of the
Community Charter

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY TAXATION EXEMPTION
BYLAW NO. 13, 2004.**

2. Pursuant to section 224(1) and (2)(a) of the *Community Charter*,
Council does hereby exempt from taxation under section 197(1)(a) of the said
Act for the year 2005:

- (1) 50 percent of the museum building, 50 percent of the parking
under the museum building, 50 percent of the area of land
occupied by the museum building, and 100 percent of the
land used as a Japanese garden owned by the NATIONAL
NIKKEI HERITAGE CENTRE SOCIETY INC., 6688
Southoaks Crescent (Roll No. 3261-6688) more particularly
described as Lot 2, District Lot 96, Group 1, New
Westminster District, Plan LMP49733;

The herein described tax-exempt parcel contains by
calculation 2876 square metres, and is shown outlined in
black on the plan annexed to Bylaw No. 11168 filed in the
Land Title Office at New Westminster.

- (2) 50 percent of the land and improvements owned by THE
CANADIAN RED CROSS SOCIETY, 3400 Lake City Way
(Roll No. 7405-3400) more particularly described as Lot 1,
District Lot 42, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan
BCP7538.
