- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY RECREATION FEES AND ADMISSIONS BYLAW 2005.**
- 2. Burnaby Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission may charge for the use of, or admission to, sports and recreation facilities the fees specified in Schedule "A".
- 3. Burnaby Recreation Fees and Admissions Bylaw 2004, Bylaw No. 11754, is repealed.
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force on the first day of September, 2005.
