BYLAW NO. 11946

A BYLAW to authorize an application to register
title to a certain portion of dedicated park

WHEREAS pursuant to section 29 of the *Community Charter* land in a municipality that is dedicated for the purpose of a park by a subdivision plan, explanatory plan, or reference plan is vested in the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to authorize application to be made to register the City's title to that portion of a dedicated park more particularly hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY PARK TITLE REGISTRATION BYLAW NO. 1, 2005.**
2. Council hereby authorizes an application to be made for the registration of the City of Burnaby's title to ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Burnaby, in the Province of British Columbia, more particularly known and described as all those portions of park dedicated by Plan 48256, District Lot 4, Group 1, New Westminster District and containing 17.9 m² and shown outlined and described as Pcl. A, on Reference Plan prepared by G.N. Holme, B.C.L.S., and deposited in the Land Title Office under Number BCP _____, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.
