BYLAW NO. 12065

A BYLAW to authorize a heritage revitalization agreement
agreement for the George S. and Jessie Haddon House

WHEREAS Council has identified the George S. and Jessie Haddon House (hereinafter referred to as the “Heritage House”) located at 5520 Buckingham Avenue, having the legal description:

006-464-289

Lot 115, District Lot 85, Group 1, New Westminster District,
Plan 30131

(hereinafter referred to as the “Lands”)

as a heritage property and has directed that the Heritage House be entered on the community heritage register as a protected heritage resource;

AND WHEREAS **CELINE PODINS AND FIONA SCHWIZGEBEL** are the registered owners of the Lands and have agreed to undertake measures to conserve the Heritage House in return for variation of the Burnaby Zoning Bylaw requirements to allow for the use and development of the property as guided by the architectural plans titled “Proposed Heritage House Relocation – 5520 Buckingham Avenue” prepared by Alan Diamond Architect and further to undertake the conservation work of the Heritage House as specified in the Heritage Revitalization Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY HERITAGE REVITALIZATION BYLAW NO. 2, 2006.**
2. The City Clerk is authorized to execute on behalf of the City a heritage revitalization agreement in substantially the same form as that which is attached to and forms part of this Bylaw.
