CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 12286

A BYLAW authorizing the expenditure of monies in the Local Improvement Fund

WHEREAS there is an unappropriated balance in the Local Improvement Fund established pursuant to Bylaw No. 4084 of \$19,253,225.79 as at the 13th day of May, 2007;

AND WHEREAS Council has adopted a program for the construction of roadworks at various locations in the City and has enacted the following Construction Bylaw for the undertaking of works at the costs set out:

Bylaw No. <u>Amount</u> 12279 \$1,200,000

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend \$1,200,000 of the said balance for the Roadworks program (hereinafter called "the said works") and to repay to the said Local Improvement Fund from current revenues over a fifteen year period that amount together with interest at the annual interest rate applicable to internal borrowing;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY LOCAL IMPROVEMENT FUND EXPENDITURE BYLAW NO. 5, 2007.

2. The sum of \$1,200,000 is hereby appropriated from the Local Improvement Fund to be expended on the said works; and such sum, together with interest at the annual rate applicable to internal borrowing, shall be repaid to the Local Improvement Fund over a fifteen year period.
