CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 12298

A BYLAW respecting replacement trees

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- This Bylaw may be cited as BURNABY TREE BYLAW 1996, AMENDMENT BYLAW
 2007.
- 2. Subsection (g) of section 4 of Burnaby Tree Bylaw 1996 is struck out, and the following substituted in its place:
 - "(g) to cut down a protected tree as defined in section 2(o)(i) or 2(o)(v) on a residential lot on which there is a dwelling except during the period commencing three (3) months before a demolition permit for that dwelling or a building permit for a new dwelling is applied for and ending one (1) year after an occupancy permit is issued for the new dwelling."
- 3. Section 7 of the said Bylaw is amended:
 - (a) by striking out "and" at the end of subsection (e);
 - (b) by striking out "Bylaw." at the end of subsection (f) and substituting "Bylaw; and"; and;
 - (c) by adding after subsection (f) the following as subsection (g):
 - "(g) shall be forfeited to the City if the replacement trees are not planted within one year

planted within one year

- (i) from the date that an occupancy permit is issued for the building or buildings and improvements in respect of which the tree cutting permit was issued; or
- (ii) from the date that the tree cutting permit is issued if subsection (i) does not apply."
- 4. Subsection (2) of section 15 of the said Bylaw is amended by striking out subsections (a) and (b) and substituting:
 - "(a) in the case of coniferous species, be not less than 2m (6.562 ft.) in height;
 - (b) in the case of the deciduous species:
 - (i) be a single tree not less than 5cm (2in) in diameter; or
 - (ii) be two trees not less than 2.5 cm(1in.) in diameter."
