BYLAW NO. 12947

A BYLAW respecting Stage 1 and Stage 2
water restrictions

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY WATERWORKS REGULATION BYLAW 1953, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2011.**

2. Subsection (a) of section 1.1 of Appendix 1 of Schedule “B” of Burnaby Waterworks Regulation Bylaw 1953 is repealed and the following substituted in its place:

“(a) Water Lawns, except:


- (i) at residential premises with even numbered civic addresses, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.;
- (ii) at residential premises with odd numbered civic addresses, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.;
- (iii) at non-residential premises with even numbered civic addresses, on Mondays and Wednesdays between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6 a.m. and Fridays between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.; and
- (iv) at non-residential premises with odd numbered civic addresses, on Tuesdays and Thursdays between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. and on Fridays between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.”

3. Subsection (a) of section 2.1 of Appendix 1 of Schedule "B" of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted in its place:

" (a) Water Lawns, except:

- (i) at residential premises with even numbered civic addresses, on Mondays only between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.;
- (ii) at residential premises with odd numbered civic addresses, on Thursdays only between the hours of 4:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m.;
- (iii) at non-residential premises with even numbered civic addresses, on Wednesdays only between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; and
- (iv) at non-residential premises with odd numbered civic addresses, on Tuesdays only between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. "
