

**CITY OF BURNABY**

**BYLAW NO. 13052**

**A BYLAW to amend Burnaby Solid Waste and  
Recycling Bylaw 2010**

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING BYLAW 2010, AMENDMENT BYLAW 2012.**
2. Subsection 2(3) of Burnaby Solid Waste and Recycling Bylaw 2010 is amended by striking out “whatever size and weight as may be” and substituting “the size and weight as”.
3. Subsection 2(13) of the said Bylaw is amended by adding “, diapers” after “grease”.
4. Subsection 2(14) of the said Bylaw is amended by striking out “unless otherwise provided,”.
5. Section 2 of the said Bylaw is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection (15):

“(15A) ‘green bin receptacle’ means a container provided to a dwelling or premises by the City or a private contractor for the deposit of yard waste and food scraps;”
6. Subsection 2(20) of the said Bylaw is amended by adding “from landscaping works” after “debris”.
7. Subsection 2(24) of the said Bylaw is amended by adding “or human” after “animal”.
8. Subsection 2(29) of the said Bylaw is amended by striking out “By-Law 250, 2009” and substituting “Bylaw”.
9. Subsection 2(36) of the said Bylaw is amended by adding “industrial”, after “institutional,”.

10. Subsection 2(40) of the said Bylaw is repealed.
11. Subsection 4(1) of the said Bylaw is amended by adding “, food scraps” after “yard waste”.
12. Subsections 4(8), 5(1), 5(4), 5(6)(b), 5(6)(d), 5(7), 6(1)(b) and 6(1)(e) of the said Bylaw are amended by striking out “yard waste receptacle” and substituting “green bin receptacle”.
13. The heading of section 5 of the said Bylaw is amended by adding “, FOOD SCRAPS” after “YARD WASTE”.
14. Subsection 5(5) of the said Bylaw is repealed.
15. Subsection 5(6)(e) of the said Bylaw is repealed.
16. Subsection 5(6)(f) of the said Bylaw is repealed and the following substituted:

“(f) place the garbage receptacle, green bin receptacle and blue box out at the collection point near the boundary of the property so that they do not impede pedestrian or vehicle traffic, and with at least one (1) meter clear space on all sides of each receptacle and three (3) meters of clear space above each receptacle, no earlier than 8:00 p.m. on the day before collection day and no later than 7:00 a.m. on the collection day;”
17. Subsection 5(6)(g) of the said Bylaw is repealed.
18. Subsections 5(8) and 9(4) of the said Bylaw are amended by striking out “yard waste receptacles” and substituting “green bin receptacles”.
19. The heading of section 6 of the said Bylaw is amended by adding “, FOOD SCRAPS” after “YARD WASTE”.
20. Subsection 6(1) of the said Bylaw is amended:
  - (a) by striking out “Engineer.” in subsection (e) and substituting “Engineer;”; and

(b) by adding the following subsection after subsection (e):

“(f) replace any lost or stolen receptacles at their cost.”.

21. Section 6 of the said Bylaw is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection (2):

“(2A) Every owner or occupier of a premises shall place yard waste and food scraps into a green bin receptacle without contamination.”

22. Subsection 6(3)(c) of the said Bylaw is amended by adding “and signage” after “storage”.

23. Subsection 7(1)(d) of the said Bylaw is amended by striking out “By-Law” and substituting “Bylaw”.

24. Section 9 of the said Bylaw is amended by adding the following subsection after subsection (6):

“(7) The property tax credit set out in part E of Schedule A shall not apply to vacant properties.

25. Schedule A to the said Bylaw is repealed and Schedule A to this Bylaw is substituted in its place.

**A. Multi-family, institutional, commercial and industrial rates for garbage receptacles (rates are subject to HST)**

**B. Multi-family, institutional, commercial and industrial rates for recycling and/or green bin receptacles (rates are subject to HST)**

<b>Municipal Receptacle and Type</b>	<b>Rent per month (no disposal fee)</b>
Cardboard container – 3, 4 or 6 cu.yd.	\$20.00 <sup>(2)</sup>
Recycling toter – mixed paper, newspaper or mixed containers	\$6.60 <sup>(2)</sup>
Green bin container – food scraps or yard waste	\$5.00 <sup>(2)</sup>

<sup>(2)</sup> Recycling and/or green bin services only available to customers with an existing City garbage account

**C. Burnaby Yard Waste Depot charges:**

- (1) \$63 per tonne, inclusive of HST
- (2) non minimum charge
- (3) no fee for a resident of Burnaby with a load of 100 kg or less (limit of one free visit per day)

D. Cost for purchase/replacement of new receptacles is outlined in the table below. A \$25 service fee is also payable in addition to the replacement cost.

360	January 1 to March 31, 2012 - \$275/year/property charge  April 1 to December 31, 2012 - \$295/year/property charge
