# A BYLAW respecting recreation facility rentals and admissions

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY RECREATION FEES AND ADMISSIONS BYLAW 2012.**
- 2. Burnaby Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission may charge for use of, or admission to, sports and recreation facilities the fees specified in Schedule "A".
- 3. Burnaby Recreation Fees and Admissions Bylaw 2011, Bylaw No. 12967, is repealed effective the first day of September, 2012.
- 4. This Bylaw comes into force on the first day of September, 2012.
