## **BYLAW NO. 13239**

## A BYLAW to extend for one year the redemption period for a parcel of land sold at a tax sale

WHEREAS on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2012 the City Collector did sell by public auction for delinquent taxes, pursuant to Part 11 of the <u>Local Government Act</u>, that parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the City of Burnaby, having a civic address of 7647 Willard Street, and more particularly know and described as:

Parcel Identifier (PID): 009-000-461 Lot 41, DL 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 28537 (the "Lands");

AND WHEREAS the City of Burnaby was declared the purchaser of the Lands at the tax sale pursuant to Section 407 (4) of the Local Government Act;

AND WHEREAS the period for redemption of the Lands will expire on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2013;

AND WHEREAS the City of Burnaby may by bylaw, pursuant to Section 417 (6) of the Local Government Act, extend for one year the period for redemption of the Lands;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY TAX SALE REDEMPTION PERIOD** EXTENSION BYLAW 2013. 2. Pursuant to Section 417 (6) of the Local Government Act the period for redemption of the Lands is hereby extended to the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2014.
