

**CITY OF BURNABY**

**BYLAW NO. 13525**

**A BYLAW to amend the Burnaby  
Inter-municipal Business Licence Bylaw 2013**

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **“BURNABY INTER-MUNICIPAL BUSINESS LICENCE BYLAW 2013, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2015”**.
2. The Burnaby Inter-Municipal Business Licence Bylaw 2013 is amended by:
  - (a) repealing section 2 and marking it as **“REPEALED”**;
  - (b) deleting the definition of *“Inter-municipal Business”* and substituting the following:

*““Inter-municipal Business” means a trades contractor or other professional related to the construction industry or a contractor who performs maintenance, repair and/or inspections of land and buildings outside of its Principal Municipality;”*
  - (c) deleting section 11 and substituting the following:

*“11. Despite section 12, the Inter-municipal Business Licence fee will not be pro-rated.”*
  - (d) deleting section 12 and substituting the following:

*“12. The length of term of an Inter-municipal Business Licence is twelve (12) months, except that at the option of a Participating Municipality, the length of term of the initial Inter-municipal Business Licence issued to an Inter-municipal Business in that municipality may be less than twelve*

(12) months in order to harmonize the expiry date of the *Inter-municipal Business Licence* with the expiry date of the *Municipal Business Licence*.”



3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2016.

Read a second time this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 2015

Read a third time this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 2015
