BYLAW NO. 13737

**A BYLAW amending the Burnaby Community
Heritage Commission Bylaw**

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY COMMUNITY HERITAGE COMMISSION BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2017.**

2. Burnaby Community Heritage Commission Bylaw is amended:
 - (a) at Section 3, by deleting “section 15 of the Heritage Conservation Act” and substituting “Section 597 of the *Local Government Act*”;

 - (b) at Section 4, by deleting “Part 27” and substituting “Part 15”;

 - (c) at Section 5, by deleting subsection (1) in its entirety and substituting the following:
 - “(1) The Commission shall be appointed by Council at any regular meeting and shall consist of up to ten members as follows:
 - (a) up to three members of Council;
 - (b) one member of the Burnaby Historical Society;
 - (c) one member of the Burnaby Parks, Recreation, and Culture Commission;
 - (d) one member from the community at large;
 - (e) three members from the community with a background in history, architecture, landscape architecture, archival studies, building conservation and restoration, or a related field; and
 - (f) one member from the local business community.”

- (d) at Section 5, by deleting subsection (4) and substituting the following:
- “(4) The Director of Planning and Building, the City Archivist, and a representative of the Burnaby Village Museum or their delegates may attend all meetings of the Commission but shall not vote.”
- (e) at Section 6, by deleting subsection (1) and substituting the following:
- “(1) Council shall appoint from the members of Council on the Commission a Chair, and that person shall preside over the meetings for one year or until replaced by a new Chair.”
- (f) at Section 6, by deleting subsection (2) and substituting the following:
- “(2) Council shall annually appoint from the members of Council on the Commission a Vice-Chair, and that person shall preside over the meetings in the absence of the Chair for one year.”
- (g) at Section 6, by deleting “Committee” in subsection (4) and substituting “Commission”.
