BYLAW NO. 13756

**A BYLAW amending the Burnaby
Freedom of Information Bylaw**

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY FREEDOM OF INFORMATION BYLAW, AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 1, 2017.**
2. Burnaby Freedom of Information Bylaw is amended:
 - (a) by deleting Section 1 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

“1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY FREEDOM OF INFORMATION BYLAW 1995.”**
 - (b) at Section 2, by deleting subsection (a) in its entirety and substituting the following:

“(a) “Act” means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, Chapter 165;”
 - (c) at Section 2, by deleting subsection (c) in its entirety and substituting the following:

“(c) “co-ordinator” means the person designated in section 3(2) as the Information and Privacy Co-ordinator;”

(d) at Section 2, by deleting subsection (d) in its entirety and marking it
“Repealed”; and

(e) at Section 3, by deleting subsection (1) in its entirety and substituting the
following:


“(1) The City Manager is designated the “head” for the purposes of the
Act.”


